Lack of opportunities for exchanging knowledge and studies for the practitioners and researchers on profound intellectual and multiple disabilities were highlighted at the roundtable of the Special Interest Research Group on Profound Intellectual and Multiple Disabilities (PIMD) in Rome in 2010.

The delegates from Taiwan and Japan decided to hold an Asia-Pacific Roundtable on PIMD (A-PIMD) once a year until the 3rd Asia-Pacific regional conference to be held in Tokyo in 2013. It is a great pleasure for me to host the first Asia-Pacific Roundtable on PIMD.

The theme of each roundtable will be chosen from the World Health Organisation's (WHO) aims for promoting the right of persons with disability.
